2009 Dance Performance Workshop and Summer Intensives

For almost 20 years, the Dance Division of the Arts Conservatory of Central Pennsylvania has provided the region's most acclaimed and successful classical ballet training program. Each summer, the program features a multi-week "Dance Performance Workshop" for intermediate and advanced students who come for a full-day of training plus afternoons rehearsing classical and contemporary repertoire for performance during the summer.

Full-day "intensive" training programs are available for advanced students throughout the summer. This year, we are also pleased to welcome guest ballet instructor **Nina Danilova**, a former member of the Kirov Ballet and a faculty member of the North Carolina School of the Arts. Ms. Danilova will be in residence at the Arts Conservatory during Week 5 (August 3rd to August 7th).

2nd Annual "Summer Youth Theater Festival" – Performance Camp #1, "Grease – School Version" (Audition Required) Ages 14 to 20. Cast includes up to 20 actors and singers (boys and girls). Scholarships are available.

Here is Rydell High's senior class of 1959; duck-tailed, hot-rodding "Burger Palace Boys" and their gum-snapping "Pink Ladies" in bobby sox and pedal pushers, evoking the look and sound of the 1950s in this rollicking musical. An 8-year run on Broadway and two subsequent revivals along with innumerable school and community productions place *Grease* among the world's most popular musicals. The "School Version" is appropriately edited for young performers.

This comprehensive youth theater camp is designed to provide students with a complete educational and performing experience. Each day, participants will receive instruction in acting, improvisation, movement / dance, music and singing, all with the professional and specialized instructors on the Arts Conservatory faculty. The camp culminates with a fully-staged and costumed performance of *Grease – School Version* (performance date/time TBA).

2009 Summer Enrollment Information

In any type of performing arts education, the best value is achieved when students attend a substantial number of classes and lessons over time. To enable students to realize that value, the Arts Conservatory uses a "Progressive Tuition Scale" so that students pay less per hour the more frequently they attend each week.

The 2009 Summer Program was designed to give families the greatest flexibility and value with an assurance of excellence in training. Students may enroll for as little as one complete week, or for as much as eight weeks. Program weeks often fill up quickly, so enroll as soon as possible!

REGISTRATION FEE: There is a one-time \$40.00 Registration Fee for *New* students, and for *Former* students who were not enrolled at the conclusion of the last session. The Registration Fee is paid once with the initial tuition payment, and never again as long as the student enrolls again for the following session. The maximum family Registration Fee is \$80.00. *Continuing* students do not pay another Registration Fee if they enroll during the "Pre-Registration" period for the next Full Session.

"Summer Only Registration Fee": Students who are enrolling only for summer programs may pay a \$20 "Summer Only" Registration Fee. This applies only to the 2009 Summer Program, and is not applied to the next session. If the student enrolls for the next session, the entire \$40 regular Registration Fee will be due at that time.

TUITION PAYMENTS: Tuition for the 2009 Summer Program may be paid in full at registration, or in two equal installments. The first half must be paid at registration, and the second half must be received on or before Monday, June 22nd (the first day of the session).

All tuition paid is non-refundable and non-transferable, unless the Arts Conservatory cancels a class or alters the schedule in a way which prevents a student from being able to attend.

ENROLLMENT DATES: In order to ensure good enrollment levels for each program, students must register before the following dates:

For programs in Weeks 1, 2, 3, and 4 (June 22nd – July 17th): Enrollment Deadline is **June 1, 2009**

For programs in Weeks 5, 6, 7, and 8 (August 3rd – August 28th): Enrollment Deadline is **July 1, 2009**

FAQs ABOUT TUITION, FEES, AND ENROLLMENT

Q: Do you have discounts for families?

A: Yes, after one student enrolls at the Arts Conservatory, **additional members of the same family receive 10% off their class tuition** (private lessons are not included). We also feature a "Male Dancer Scholarship" of 25% off dance tuition for boys and men.

Q: Are there scholarships or financial aid?

A: We believe it is important to provide high-quality arts instruction to everyone, regardless of financial circumstances. There is a limited amount of aid available in the form of "Work-Study" for qualified students and families. Ask at the front desk during registration for additional information.
